

## GENERAL INFORMATION ON TRAVEL TO AUSTRIA

### THE FOLLOWING VACCINES ARE LICENSED IN AUSTRIA:

- Comirnaty/BNT162b2/Tozinameran (INN) from **BioNtech/Pfizer: 2 doses**
- ChAdOx1\_nCoV-19/ChAdOx1-S/AZD1222/Vaxzevria/ COVID-19 Vaccine AstraZeneca from **AstraZeneca**, and Covishield from Serum Institute of India: **2 doses**
- COVID-19 Vaccine Janssen from **Johnson & Johnson/Janssen Pharmaceuticals/Ad26.COVS.2.S** Janssen (US +NL sites): **1 dose**
- Covid-19 Vaccine Moderna/mRNA-1273 from **Moderna: 2 doses**
- **Sinopharm** / BIBP (Beijing Bio-Institute of Biological Products Co-Ltd.) SARS-CoV-2 Vaccine (Vero Cell), Inactivated (InCoV): **2 doses**
- **Sinovac-CoronaVac** vaccine, SARS-CoV-2 Vaccine (Vero Cell), Inactivated: 2 doses

Only these vaccines are licensed in Austria. **If you vaccinated with another vaccines, a negative molecular biological test result (e.g. PCR test), in addition to the entry requirements from your respective country, is necessary.**

All test results or medical reports must be written in German or English and must not be older than 48 hours (antigen test) or 72 hours (PCR test).

### AT THE AIRPORT AND ON BOARD

Corona entry-documents are usually checked at the airport before departure. During the flight and on the most airports the wearing of a medical protective mask is necessary.
